**Note regarding synthesizer:** owing to the huge variety of timbres / patches available on modern synths, I ask the player to approximate what is heard in the provided audio MP3 rendering. And it is important that the volume can be controlled - preferably by a foot- or expression-pedal. Also, an appropriate amplification system, sufficient to provide a full sound is desirable. Using any synth's "built-in speakers" is discouraged.
