The definition of 'smörgåsbord' is "a luncheon or supper buffet offering a variety of foods and dishes". When I started this piece in 2005, it was my intention to see if I could serve up a variety of "sound episodes".

Perhaps 65% of the piece had come together in 2005, but it was not until 2017 that the compositional muse found a way to add the remaining 35%. In a similar fashion to the G-Flat pseudo-rag piano solo.

Trombone: Rests throughout the first four measures, then a short note in measure 5 at dynamic **p**.

Timpani: Rests throughout the first four measures, then a short note in measure 5 at dynamic **p**.

Piano: Rests throughout the first four measures, then a dynamic **mf** followed by a series of eighth-note patterns.

Violin 1: Sixteenth-note patterns in measures 1-4, then rests. In measure 5, a dynamic **mp**.

Violin 2: Sixteenth-note patterns in measures 1-4, then rests. In measure 5, a dynamic **mp**.

Viola: Sixteenth-note patterns in measures 1-4, then rests. In measure 5, a dynamic **mp**.

Cello: Sixteenth-note patterns in measures 1-4, then rests. In measure 5, a dynamic **mp**.
